

Resources

- 4 mm hook
- Stylecraft Classique DK Cotton;
- Button for the fastening

Abbreviations (UK terms)

ch - chain

dc - double crochet

inc - increase by working 2 stitches in the same placedc2tog - decrease by working two double crochet together

st - stitch(s), generally referring the stitch in the previous row

slst - slip stitch

Purse

Work in rounds until row 11

Chain 13

R1: inc into second chain from hook, dc into next 11 st, inc into same stitch on the other side of the 'loose end', dc into the remaining 11 st [26]

R2-10: dc in each st [26] turn

R11: ch 1, miss first st, dc into next 12, turn

R12: ch 1, miss first st, dc into next 11, turn

R13: ch 1, dc into next 11, turn

R14: ch 1, dc into next 11, turn

R15: ch 1, dc2tog, 2 dc, 3 ch, miss 3 st, 2 dc, dc2tog, turn

R16: ch 1, 3 dc, 3 dc into 3 ch space, 3 dc.

Fasten off and sew in ends.
