Chocolate Orange Cover

Resources

- 4 mm hook
- Stylecraft Classique DK Cotton;
 - White
 - Sunflower
 - Greek Blue
 - Black
 - Dove
- Black beads for the eyes
- Terry's Chocolate Orange

Abbreviations (UK terms)

- dc** - double crochet
- inc** - increase by working 2 stitches in the same place
- dc2tog** - decrease by working two double crochet together
- st** - stitch, generally referring the stitch in the previous row
- slst** - slip stitch

Cover

Work in rounds, starting with Sunflower

R1: 6 dc into a magic ring [6]

R2: (inc) 6 times [12]

R3: (inc, dc) 6 times [18]

R4: (inc, 2 dc) 6 times [24]

R5: (inc, 3 dc) 6 times [30]

R6: (inc, 4 dc) 6 times [36]

R7-8: dc in each st. Change to *Black* [36]

R9: dc in each st. Change to *Sunflower* [36]

R10-13: dc in each st. Change to *Greek Blue* [36]

R14-16: dc in each st. [36]

R17: (dc2tog, 10 dc) 3 times [33]

R18: 4 dc, (dc2tog, 9 dc) 2 times, dc2tog, 4 dc, slst [30]

Fasten off and sew in ends.

Make up

Add black beads to eyes. Sew eyes across the black line on the cover.

Eyes (make 2)

Work in rounds, starting with White

R1: 8 dc into a magic ring [8]

R2: (inc) 8 times. Change to *Dove* [16]

R3: slst in each St [16]

Fasten off and sew in ends. Leave one long end to sew eyes on to cover.
