- 4 mm hook
- Stylecraft Classique DK Cotton; White
- Large sew on Goggle Eyes
- Terry's Chocolate Orange

Abbreviations (UK terms)

dc - double crochet

inc - increase by working 2 stitches in the same place

- dc2tog decrease by working two double crochet together
- st stitch, generally referring the stitch in the previous rowslst slip stitch
- ch chain
- **blo** back loop only
- flo front loop only
- () pattern in round brackets to be repeated
- [] number of stitches at end of round

Cover

Work in rounds, with White

- R1: 6 dc into a magic ring [6]
- R2: (inc) 6 times [12]
- R3: (inc, dc) 6 times [18]
- R4: (inc, 2 dc) 6 times [24]
- **R5**: (inc, 3 dc) 6 times [30]
- R6: (inc, 4 dc) 6 times [36]
- **R7-15**: dc in each st. [36]
- **R16**: in blo dc in each st. [36]
- **R17**: (dc2tog, 10 dc) 3 times [33]

R18: 4 dc, (dc2tog, 9 dc) 2 times, dc2tog, 5 dc [30]

Slst into next st.

Fasten off and sew in ends.



Frill

Join yarn to flo of row 16 with work upside down **R1**: 1 ch, 2dc in same stitch as chain, 2dc in each st. [72] **R2**: dc in each st. [36] Slst into next st. Fasten off and sew in ends.
