## Chocolate Orange Cover

P012

### Resources

- 4 mm hook
- Stylecraft Classique DK Cotton  
*Black, White, Poppy, Sunflower*
- 2mm black beads
- Pom-Pom maker
- Terry's Chocolate Orange

### Abbreviations (UK terms)

ch -	chain
ch sp -	chain space
dc -	double crochet
htr -	half treble crochet
inc -	increase by working 2 stitches in the same place
dc2tog -	decrease by working 2 double crochet together
st -	stitch, generally referring the stitch in the previous row
slst -	slip stitch
() -	pattern in round brackets to be repeated
[] -	number of stitches at end of round

### Cover

*Work in rounds, with Poppy*

**R1:** 6 dc into a magic ring [6]

**R2:** ( inc ) 6 times [12]

**R3:** ( inc, dc ) 6 times [18]

**R4:** ( inc, 2 dc ) 6 times [24]

**R5:** ( inc, 3 dc ) 6 times [30]

**R6:** ( inc, 4 dc ) 6 times [36]

**R7-12:** dc in each st. [36] *change to Black*

**R13-14:** dc in each st. [36] *change to Red*

**R15-16:** dc in each st. [36]

**R17:** ( dc2tog, 10 dc ) 3 times [33]

**R18:** 4 dc, ( dc2tog, 9 dc ) 2 times, dc2tog, 5 dc [30]

Slst into next st.

Fasten off and sew in ends.





# Hat

Work in rounds, with Poppy

R1: 3 dc into a magic ring [3]

R2: ( inc ) 3 times [6]

R3: dc in each st. [6]

R4: ( inc, dc ) 3 times [9]

R5: dc in each st. [9]

R6: ( inc, 2 dc ) 3 times [12]

R7: dc in each st. [12]

R8: ( inc, 3 dc ) 3 times [15]

R9: dc in each st. [15]

R10: ( inc, 4 dc ) 3 times [18]

R11: dc in each st. [18]

R12: ( inc, 5 dc ) 3 times [21]

R13: dc in each st. [21]

R14: ( inc, 6 dc ) 3 times [24]

R15: dc in each st. [24]

R16: ( inc, 3 dc ) 6 times [30]

R17: dc in each st. [30]

R18: ( inc, 4 dc ) 3 times [36]

R19: dc in each st. [36]

R20: ( inc, 5 dc ) 3 times [42] *change to White*

R21: dc in each st. [42]

## continue ...for Beard

Work in rows

R22: slst 2, dc, 6ch, skip 4, dc, slst *turn*

R23: slst into dc, (dc, 8 htr, dc ) in ch sp, slst *turn*

R24: 2dc in next dc, 2htr in next 8 st, 2dc in last st.

Fasten off and leave a long end to sew hat to cover.

## Make up

Sew the buckle in *Sunflower*, using long stitches across the black of rows 13/14 (opposite the colour change)

Attach a small white pop-pom to the top of the hat.

Position the hat at a slightly jaunty angle, so the beard falls over the buckle and leaves enough room for the eyes. Sew on using the long end.

Sew eyes on to the cover about row 10/11.

*Don't forget to sew in all the ends neatly. Once the orange is eaten all your workings can be seen!*
