Chocolate Orange Cover

Resources

- 4 mm hook
- Stylecraft Classique DK Cotton
 - Toffee
 - Ivory
 - Leaf
- 2 x 8mm Wooden Red Beads
- Terry's Chocolate Orange

Abbreviations (UK terms)

ch -	chain
dc -	double crochet
htr -	half treble crochet
tr -	treble
inc -	increase by working 2 stitches in the same place
dc2tog -	decrease by working 2 double crochet together
st -	stitch, generally referring the stitch in the previous row
slst -	slip stitch
blo -	back loop only
flo -	front loop only
() -	pattern in round brackets to be repeated
[] -	number of stitches at end of round

Cover

Work in rounds, with Ivory

R1: 6 dc into a magic ring [6]

R2: (inc) 6 times [12]

R3: (inc, dc) 6 times [18]

R4: (inc, 2 dc) 6 times [24]

R5: (inc, 3 dc) 6 times [30]

R6: (inc, 4 dc) 6 times [36]

R7-9: dc in each st. [36]

R10: flo (dc, skip 2, 6 tr in next st., skip 2) 6 times [6 'shells']

Change to Toffee

R10: blo dc in each st. [36]

R11-16: dc in each st. [36]

R17: (dc2tog, 10 dc) 3 times [33]

R18: 4 dc, (dc2tog, 9 dc) 2 times, dc2tog, 5 dc [30]

Slst into next st.

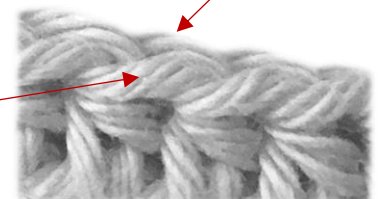
Fasten off and sew in ends.

Leaf (make 2)

Work in rows, with Leaf

Ch 8

Slst in 2nd ch from hook, dc, htr, 2tr, htr, dc, slst

Turn to work on other side of chain

Slst, dc, htr, 2tr, htr, dc, slst

Fasten off and leave an end to sew to cover.

Fig.3 – Leaf chart

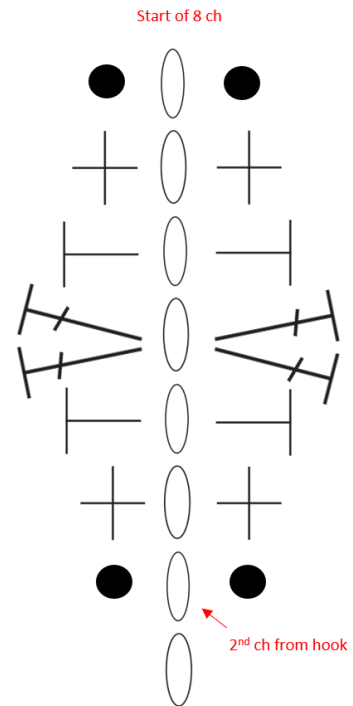
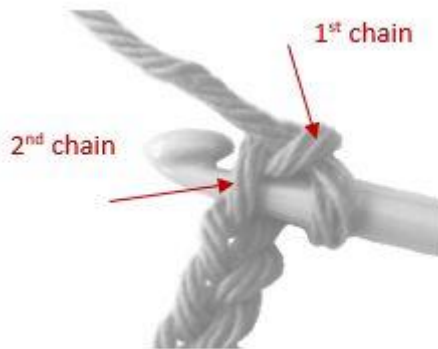


Fig.2 – Leaf

Make up

Sew the leaves to the top of the cover, using the ends to attach the wooden beads.
